Chatting With God

A brand new evangelistic one man show, written, performed and directed by Dave Jenkins. The writer, director and performer of the Urban Saints sponsored one man show, "The Word Made Fresh". This excellently received production went to 30 venues around the UK in 2007/2008. A DVD is now available of this exciting series of 13 Biblical monologues.

"Chatting With God", asks the question, "What would happen if a man who had never believed in God, suddenly started to hear His voice?" Who would he think was speaking to him? And when he found out who the voice belongs to, what would they talk about?

The story centres around Terry. A common, everyday man who is not exactly having the best time of his life. Suddenly, Terry starts to hear a voice calling his name. Is it real? Friends playing a trick on him? Is he going mad? Eventually the voice tells Terry who he is. It is God. Terry has never believed in God so can't fully comprehend this.

God quickly reveals Himself to be very real, He shows He is able to read Terry's mind. He knows everything Terry has ever done, said and thought. God proves that He knows what Terry is going to say, before he even says it.

This funny but very moving production is in 2 Acts (with a 20 min interval) and tackles almost every subject a non-believer might consider. Creation, life after death, suffering, Christmas, Easter, wrongdoing, how do we really get into Heaven and who is Jesus?

The production, ideal for anyone aged 8 and above, uses a soundtrack, provided on CD that Dave acts along to. The "Voice" has been pre-recorded along with other sounds Terry encounters during the story.

The tour will begin around Swansea and South Wales and then venture around the rest of the UK throughout Autumn 2010.
